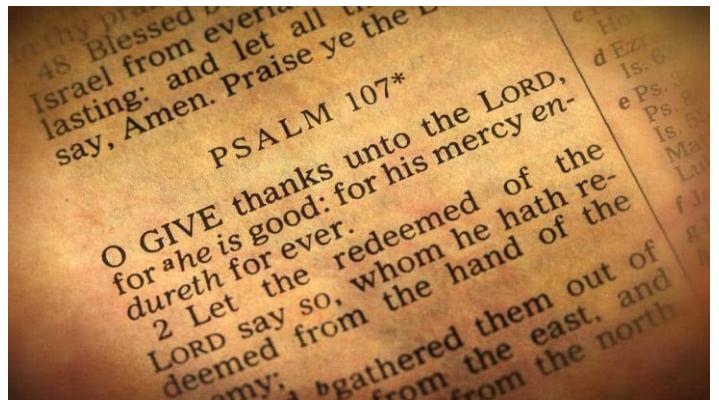
Why is it that we wait expecting something to happen without ever “asking” for help. We think:

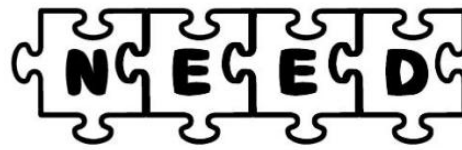
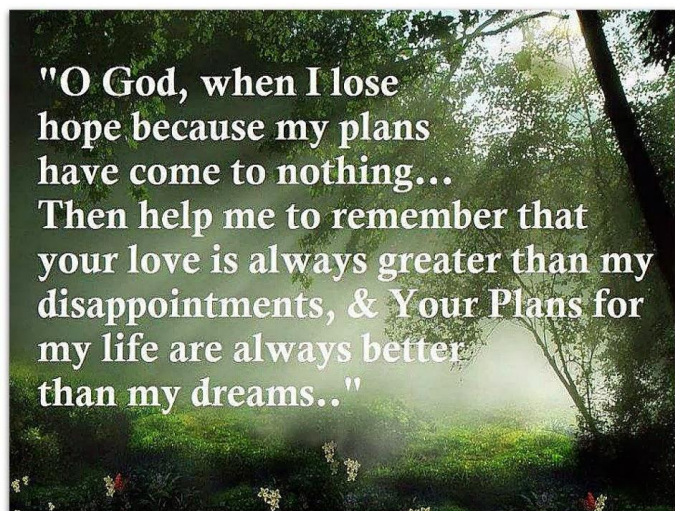
